Parliament's deadlock, non-passage of proposed bills like blocking the nation's path

It is clear that if both the parties stick to their respective stand then it will be difficult for the Parliament to function. If this happens then it will be very unfortunate. Such a situation may also arise that the budget has to be passed without debate. This will not be good, but the Parliament can function only when both the parties give up their obstinacy. For the time being, its chances are not visible, because it is certain that Rahul Gandhi is not going to apologize for his statement given in London. On the one hand, where Mallikarjun Kharge has made it clear that Rahul Gandhi is not going to apologize, on the other hand other Congress leaders are trying to prove that their leader did not say anything in London as is being told. Just as it is unlikely that Rahul Gandhi will apologize, it is also unlikely that the Modi government will agree to the opposition's demand for setting up a Joint Parliamentary Committee to probe the Adani case. One reason for this is that the Supreme Court has already announced the formation of a six-member committee and secondly, the Joint Parliamentary Committees constituted so far in financial matters have either covered up in the name of investigation or partisan politics. It also cannot be overlooked that the main objective of the opposition's demand to get the Adani case probed by a Joint Parliamentary Committee is to keep the matter alive till the next general elections. Since the government has realized this intention of the opposition, it is not ready to pay attention to its demand. In this session of Parliament, not only the budget is to be debated, but at least three dozen bills are also to be passed. Many of these are very important Bills. If the proposed bill is not passed due to the deadlock between the ruling party and the opposition, then it will be a work to stop the way of the nation. It would be appropriate that the ruling party and the opposition should understand that by creating a situation of deadlock in the Parliament, they are only working to disappoint the public.

The middle way is the easy way to resolve any dispute

The easiest way to resolve any dispute is to find a middle ground. It becomes all the more necessary to do so in such a case, in which both the parties are adamant on their stand, but in the matter of removing the deadlock in Parliament, senior Congress leader Jairam Ramesh is saying that there is a middle way. Not only. This is an adamant attitude and it means that the Congress will stick to its demand that the Adani case be probed by a Joint Parliamentary Committee (JPC). Not surprisingly, the ruling party will retaliate by demanding that Rahul Gandhi be punished for his statement. An apology has to be given, which he gave in London and in which he said that why America and Europe are not speaking anything when democracy has ended in India. If this happens, which is also looking likely, then the second phase of the budget session of Parliament may end without any work. In this situation, there may be a need to pass the Finance Bill without any debate. The opposition will suffer the most from this, but perhaps it is not ready to pay attention to it. If the Parliament does not work, then about three dozen proposed bills will also go in cold storage. This may not affect the health of the ruling party and the opposition, but it is sure to harm the country. It is understandable that the Congress and the parties standing with it should insist that the Adani case should be investigated, but there is no justification for insisting on getting the investigation done by the JPC. The experience so far of getting financial matters and especially matters related to the stock market through JPC shows that this method of investigation is nothing but a waste of time. Hardly the root of any matter could be reached through JPC. JPC's investigation becomes an arena of party politics. When the committee constituted by the Supreme Court is probing the matter and all the members of this committee have been decided by the Apex Court itself, then there is no point in insisting on the demand for JPC inquiry. Does he not trust the Supreme Court and its committee? In any case, the way in which Rahul Gandhi is being insisted on apologizing in response to the demand for a JPC probe into the Adani case, Parliament has started to look like a hostage.

Environment Ministry has notified the Plastic Waste Management Rules, 2021. These rules ban specific single-use plastic items that have "low utility and high litter potential" by 2022. The permitted thickness of plastic bags, currently 50 microns, will be increased to 75 microns from September 30, 2021, and 120 microns from December 31, 2022. At the policy level, the concept of Extended Producer Responsibility (EPR), already mentioned under the 2016 Rules, is to be promoted. The Central Pollution Control Board, along with state pollution bodies, will monitor the ban, identify violations and impose penalties as already prescribed under the Environment Protection Act, 1986.

The Central Pollution Control Board has reported that 22 states have announced bans on single-use plastics in the past, but this has had little impact on the menace of microplastics choking wetlands and waterways and drifting into the oceans. So far, 22 states and union territories have joined the fight to beat plastic pollution and have announced a ban on single-use plastics such as carry bags, cups, plates, cutlery, straws and thermocol products. India has also won global praise for its "Beat Plastic Pollution" resolution announced on World Environment Day last year, under which it has pledged to eliminate single-use plastic by 2022. Directives have been issued at the national, state and local levels – for example, to all petrochemical industries – not to supply raw materials to industries engaged in the banned items. Pollution Control Committees will modify or cancel the consent issued under the Air/Water Act to industries engaged in single-use plastic items.
