In Dwapar Yuga, Draupadi, the wife of the Pandavas, could not be dismembered, because Shri Krishna had saved her from being insulted by his illusion, but no 'Krishna' could be made in Manipur of Kali Yuga, as a result, 3 women were paraded naked in public and a 21-year-old girl was gang-raped. This is a hallmark of the thinking of a state of new India...! This heinous act and heinous criminal incident happened on 4th May and we are analyzing on 21st July, because even the Prime Minister of the country was not aware of this shameful, inhuman, obscene incident. It is clear from his statement that this incident has left him pained and angry. However, we are not ready to believe that the Prime Minister would not be aware of such an incident. More or less BJP Chief Minister N. Biren Singh must have briefed! Were the heads of intelligence agencies who regularly brief the Prime Minister not aware of such a dreadful incident?

Then what is the intelligence system doing in a troubled and violence-ridden state like Manipur? The Governor of Manipur is also a woman and a representative of the Centre. The Chief Minister clarifies that 100 such cases have happened in Manipur, that's why the internet had to be shut down. Don't talk about a single case, look at the ground reality. However, when this video came to the fore through Twitter, not only the brutality and brutality got exposed, everything got exposed. We are thankful that this obscene video came to the notice of the Chief Justice of the country Justice Chandrachud and he considered it a violation of constitutional, human rights. He was also infuriated because such 'monstrous acts' are not acceptable in a democratic country. The global prestige of the country has become naked. Our civilization, humanity, security forces, police and the population of that area also became naked.

The women kept on crying and pleading, but the entire area remained mute spectators. The respect and dignity of the woman was destroyed. Only the faces of the crowd who had committed this heinous crime kept smiling like demons. Of course, Prime Minister Modi has given a statement that he will not spare the culprits, after that a total of 4 criminals including the main accused have been arrested. The Chief Minister has assured to get the criminals hanged, but the trust on the Chief Minister has been broken. After 78 days, this shocking and horrifying truth of Manipur has come to the fore through a video. Whose basic responsibility is it? The Prime Minister and the Home Minister should brainstorm on this. Admit it or not, but the Chief Minister of his double engine government in Manipur has failed, failed and been incompetent in handling the state.

If he is not replaced, Manipur will become a national issue and a lot can slip out of the hands of those in power. The manner in which women's dignity was stripped naked is more horrifying than the Meitei-Kuki caste conflict. Actually it has religion and caste reservation in its womb. The cycle of violence, arson and looting that has been going on for the last 80 days cannot be retaliated by making women naked in public. There should be a churn on the reservation policy.

Analysis: Poverty alleviation achievement and reason for India's praise from UNDP

According to the UNDP report, between the years 2015-16 to 2019-21, the number of poor in India declined by 38 percent. What was so special during this period that there was an unprecedented speed in reducing poverty, due to which UNDP had to praise India! Recently, in the Multidimensional Poverty Index, 2023 report published by the United Nations Development Program (UNDP), India has been praised for performing better than other countries in poverty alleviation. In 2015, SDG 1 of the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) expected the world to end all forms of poverty by 2030. The report for the year 2023 expressed satisfaction that significant progress has been made globally towards this goal. Internationally, the UNDP uses a definition of poverty called multidimensional poverty. This definition is the same for all countries. A uniform assessment of poverty is not possible due to the different definitions of poverty used by the governments of different countries of the world. Due to this it also becomes difficult to make comparisons between different countries of the world. The UNDP's multidimensional poverty measure includes several elements that are common across countries. This includes nutrition, child mortality, years of schooling, school attendance, cooking fuel, sanitation, drinking water, electricity, housing and assets. Multidimensional poverty has been estimated in different years based on the availability of data in different countries. Therefore, a comparative study of poverty in different countries in any one year is not possible with UNDP data. The preliminary data available with UNDP for different countries is from 2005-06 to 2019-21. Therefore, it is not possible to ascertain from the data published in the report how much and when poverty has reduced comparatively in all the countries of the world during a given period. For India, the UNDP data details three years, 2005-06, 2015-16 and 2019-21. According to this data, in the year 2005-06 in India, 55.1 percent of the population i.e. 645 million people were suffering from multidimensional poverty. After 10 years, in the year 2015-16, this figure was reduced to 27.7 percent i.e. 37 crores. During these 10 years, the rate of reduction in poverty percentage was 6.6 percent per annum. But in the period 2015-16 to 2019-21, the proportion of poor suffering from multidimensional poverty decreased to only 16.4 per cent of the population; And the number of poor came down to 23 crores. That is, in just five years, 140 million people came out of poverty and the pace of poverty reduction increased to more than 10 percent annually. It is important to point out that the number of poor fell by 38 per cent in the five years between 2015-16 and 2019-21, including the worst pandemic in over a year. In such a situation, it would be necessary to understand that what was so special during this period that there was an unprecedented speed in reducing poverty, due to which UNDP had to praise India! This is not only good news for India, but also important news and lesson for the world. The preliminary data on multidimensional poverty published by UNDP are for different years. Of the 150.8 million poor people in the 81 countries assessed by UNDP (for which the agency has published data), 645 million people (in 2005-06) were from India. That is, more than 42.8 percent of the poor of these 81 countries lived in India. But the latest figures of UNDP show that the total number of poor in these 81 countries of the world has now come down to 974 million, but the remarkable and interesting fact is that India's contribution to this number is only 230 million. That is, now only 23.7 percent of the poor people of these 81 countries come from India. It also means that the contribution of some other countries to the number of people living in multidimensional poverty is higher than before. Not only this, while the combined Multidimensional Poverty Index of 81 countries has now come down from 0.275 to 0.203, India's index has come down from 0.283 in 2005-06 to 0.122 in 2015-16 and only 0.069 in 2019-21, which is a great achievement. It is a matter of pride for India. The world needs to take a lesson from this that it should also accelerate efforts to remove multidimensional poverty on the lines of India. The Narendra Modi government paid special attention to the determinants of multidimensional poverty. Today the child mortality rate in India has come down to just 1.5 per cent, which was 2.2 per cent in 2015-16. There has also been a drastic improvement in the percentage of undernourished and undernourished children, which has come down from 44.3 per cent in 2005-06 to 21.1 per cent in 2015-16 and 11.8 per cent in 2019-21. Talking about housing, in the last eight years, about three crore houses, both urban and rural, have been built under the Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana, on which assistance of five lakh crore rupees (about \$ 60 billion) has been given by the Center. Due to Corona, the target of pucca housing for all could not be completed on time, but till now only a few lakh people are left, who do not have a pucca house. According to UNDP, in the year 2015-16, 23.5 percent of the total population was deprived of pucca and comfortable houses and only 13.6 percent in 2019-21. Har Ghar Nal Se Jal, another ambitious scheme of the Modi government, has also made rapid progress, and according to UNDP, only 2.7 per cent of the population was deprived of safe drinking water in 2019-21. Talking about cleanliness, 11 crore toilets have been constructed in the last eight years. 'Prime Minister Ujjwala Yojana' Under this, 9.59 crore free gas connections were given to poor women till March, 2023, while there were a total of 31.26 crore LPG gas connections in the country. There is now a very small percentage of our population left who do not have access to clean cooking fuel in the form of LPG gas connections. And the government claims that electricity has reached 100 percent of the country's villages. This is a lesson for the world. Multidimensional poverty can also be removed. This requires political will and efforts.

President's rule in Manipur is the need of the hour.

Today the government is appealing not to share the video of the incident on social media. But can the government answer that if the power of social media was not there, would the Prime Minister have come forward to give a statement today? Would the Supreme Court have been able to know the seriousness of this matter? Would the whole country know how dire the situation in Manipur is? It is the power of social media that today the Prime Minister had to be embarrassed on Manipur and had to make a statement before the monsoon session of the Rajya Sabha. He also assured that whoever is guilty will not be spared under any circumstances. Who are the culprits? How will their guilt be fixed? What punishment will they get? Only the time to come will tell. For the time being, can't the government impose President's Rule in Manipur to save it? The Biren government of Manipur has proved to be a complete failure in fulfilling its obligations. In such a situation, the President's rule is the only way to instill confidence in the people there. The question that is being raised is that the incident which moved the Prime Minister, the shameful incident which put even the Supreme Court in a quandary, had the Manipur government kept that incident under wraps till now? This question is imperative because the incident is of May 4. Its FIR is also registered about two weeks after the incident. In that FIR, the whole incident has been told in detail. In such a situation, it is not at all possible that the state government along with the police and administration there is not aware of the entire incident. Today the government is appealing not to share the video of the incident on social media. But can the government answer that if the power of social media was not there, would the Prime Minister have come forward to give a statement today? Would the Supreme Court have been able to know the seriousness of this matter? Would the whole country know how dire the situation in Manipur is? The simple answer is - no. As soon as the violence started in Manipur, the state government had suspended internet service in the state. In such a situation, there is a lot that is buried in the pit of time. In the coming time, as soon as the people of that place come out, internet facility will be available, there is a possibility of many more horrifying videos coming to the fore. Things are not normal there yet. The news of violence is continuously coming to the fore. In such a situation, it is reasonable to question the functioning of the state government. Is it enough? - After the video went viral, the Chief Minister of the state N. Biren Singh is giving a statement that my sympathies are with the victimized women. Acting swiftly, the police arrested an accused on Thursday. They are giving statements as if they have done a big job by arresting a person. The question should be asked as to what the government machinery was doing for so many days. Was the video waiting to go viral? Or was it waiting for the fact that we will arrest when the whole country sees itself being ashamed? -re of this heart-wrenching incident or not? If it was, then why was it not told to the central government. The Home Minister is continuously holding meetings on the Manipur issue, so was the Home Ministry also kept away from reality? Now that everything is in front. The whole country is watching what could be worse than the worst in Manipur. The central government should take more stringent steps. The Biren government of the state, its police and administrative staff have been facing allegations that most of the people come from the Meitei community, that is why the government has given them a free hand. These allegations seem to be reality now as the women with whom this incident happened belong to the Kuki community. He was paraded naked after being released from police custody. An FIR is also registered in this matter. According to the FIR, the incident took place on May 4 in Meitei-dominated Thoubal district with women belonging to the Kuki-Jomi community. It is only 35 kilometers away from the capital Imphal. Manipur police registered an FIR in Kangpokpi district on 18 May based on the statements of the women. After this the matter was sent to the concerned police station. Only two women are visible in the video, while the victims have told that a 50-year-old woman was also ripped apart. Out of the two women seen in the video, the age of one is said to be around 20 years and the age of the other woman is said to be 40 years. The victims have told that on May 3, about one thousand people armed with modern weapons attacked their village. The houses were set on fire. The two women and the young woman ran towards the woods with their father and brother. The police also succeeded in saving these women. The police was taking these people to the police station, but two kilometers before the police station, the mob stopped them. After this the protesters snatched these women from the police. The young woman's father was killed on the spot. The women were forced to walk naked by the mob and the young woman was publicly gang-raped. According to the FIR, when the woman's 19-year-old brother tried to save her, he too was killed. This is just an FIR. Don't know how many FIRs and stories of brutality will be buried now. Be it Kuki community or Meitei community. The fire is burning equally on both sides. The chasm of animosity has become so big that it will take years to fill it. what the height of cruelty

Rohit overtakes Dhoni, becomes India's fifth highest run-scorer

Rohit Sharma has left behind Mahendra Singh Dhoni in terms of scoring the most runs for India. He is the fifth highest run scorer for the country. Now he has a chance to leave Sourav Ganguly behind. Indian captain Rohit Sharma scored a brilliant 80 in the first innings of the second Test against the West Indies. Rohit missed out on scoring another Test century, but took a special record to his name. He became the first Indian to score 2000 runs in the



World Test Championship. This was Rohit's 29th consecutive innings in Test cricket, in which he crossed the double figure. He is only the second cricketer in the world to do so. Before Rohit, Mahela Jayawardene of Sri Lanka had crossed the double figure in 29 consecutive innings. If Rohit scores 10 runs in the next innings as well, he will become the first cricketer in the world to touch double figures in 30 consecutive innings. The special thing is that while starting the innings, Rohit has touched the figure of ten in 29 consecutive innings, whereas in Test cricket, wickets fall fiercely with the new ball. Rohit Sharma has also become the fifth highest run-scorer Indian batsman in international cricket. In this case, he has left behind former Indian captain Mahendra Singh Dhoni. Rohit was already ahead of Dhoni in scoring the most runs for India, but Dhoni had also played a few matches for Asia 11. Because of this, his runs are more in international cricket. Dhoni has scored 17092 runs for India and 17266 runs in international cricket, while Rohit has scored 17281 runs for India. The list is topped by Sachin Tendulkar, who has scored 34357 runs in 664 matches. The master blaster is followed by Virat Kohli, who has scored 25461 runs. Tendulkar never played an international match for any team other than India. Kohli has also not played international cricket for Asia 11 or any ICC team. Rahul Dravid is in third place with 24208 runs. The former India captain has also played a few matches for the ICC World XI and Asia XI. Sourav Ganguly is in fourth place with 18575 runs. Rohit is very close to Ganguly and may replace him at number four in the next one year. Rohit Sharma is currently the captain of India across all formats. However, he may have to relinquish the captaincy after the ODI World Cup. If Rohit can play for the next two years and is in good form, he can score 20,000 runs for India.

World's first player to complete 500th match in Virat Test match, see full list
