Payment of Tourism

The changing steps of tourism will change the beauty of the coming times. The advertisement of facilities actually expresses the prosperity of new tourism and due to this the details of travel are changing. Transportation has now become the first definition of tourism and convenient comfort has become its first condition, so Himachal should search its pockets. Is the journey from Delhi to Manali, McLeodganj or Dalhousie in any way convenient as compared to Uttarakhand or Srinagar. Are we able to make the tourist attraction excellent like the Kashmir Valley or are we able to stay somewhere after coming to the destinations of Uttarakhand. There is a difference between the spirituality of tourism and its payment. Tourism of better payment has not started yet. Earlier, distances were not felt for a moment of peace, but now the travel solutions are competing. Already the air fare of Delhi-Dharamshala, Kullu or Shimla takes the youthful references of travel plans away from Himachal, because the person can add his tourism concerns in the nearest foreign country at a very low cost, but he loses it by coming closer to us at a much higher cost. It is a different matter that now the changing objectives of mountain travel are measuring the four-lane of Himachal or the initial inscriptions of the expansion of Kangra Airport are being written. We need cheap air services to stand close to the distance of neighboring Uttarakhand from Delhi or we will have to strengthen the narratives of tourist travels in the network of road routes. For example, if the entire journey between Delhi-Dehradun will be reduced to two and a half hours through the expressway, then we are currently proving to be laggards on the route from Delhi to Chandigarh and Chandigarh to Himachal. Similarly, the distance of 800 kilometers between Delhi and Kashmir will be reduced to just 13 hours through Vande Bharat Express. In such a situation, the tourism map of Himachal is visible in Vande Bharat reaching Amb-Andaura. Immediate and long term plans should be considered on how the journey of Vande Bharat from Delhi to Andaura in about five and a half hours can further connect Kangra valley and Hamirpur, Mandi and Bilaspur districts. Immediately, HRTC should connect some connecting routes of Dharamshala, Hamirpur, Mandi and Bilaspur with Vande Bharat, while every effort should be made to divert Una train towards Jwalaji. Similarly, convenient packages should be made by connecting Himachal's tourism with express trains from Pathankot, Kalka and Chandigarh railway stations. The irony is that during the Diwali and the spring of tourist arrivals that started after that, flights connecting Delhi to Dharamshala or Dharamshala to Jaipur have become expensive. The requests to strengthen the relationship of tourism with transport need special intervention of the government. This will be accomplished only by coordination with the neighboring states and by exploring new relationships with railway and airline companies. We will have to work with travel agents and tour operators to introduce new destinations, tribal tourism and water tourism, as well as agro tourism and our traditional fairs in new forms and sizes. Apart from business efficiency in Himachal's tourism, the transport system here needs to be made tourist-friendly, where hard work, new vision and innovation will have to be adopted to redefine the concept of a department like PWD.

Recommendations for reform in NTA, full chances of getting approval

Another important recommendation made by the Radhakrishnan Committee is that outsourcing in examinations should be completely abolished. At a time when the confidentiality of examinations is being breached repeatedly, it is not right for an agency like NTA to conduct examinations on contract and take help from outsiders in conducting them. The recommendations made for reform in the National Testing Agency (NTA), the organization that conducts medical, engineering and other all-India examinations, are likely to get approval. It is also seen that after the acceptance of these recommendations, the functioning of the NTA will improve and the damage caused to the credibility of this organization due to flaws in NEET last year will be compensated, but all this will depend on whether the recommendations of the Radhakrishnan Committee formed to improve NTA are implemented properly or not. Certainly, it is the need of the hour that NTA conducts examinations at the online level as far as possible. If there is a compulsion to conduct offline examinations due to the large number of students, then this should be done, but in this method also it is necessary to ensure that the question papers are delivered to the examination centers in digital format only. Apart from this, it should also be ensured that several sets of question papers are prepared so that if there is any mistake, there is no need to postpone or cancel the examination at the national level. There is no justification in this age of technology that question papers should be prepared and published and then sent to examination centers across the country. This process will have to be stopped compulsorily, because in the process of sending question papers, their confidentiality can be breached anywhere. Generally, examinations are breached only when question papers are leaked at some level. In fact, the arrangement of sending question papers to examination centers in digital mode should be made by NTA as well as all the institutions conducting other examinations, especially competitive examinations. Another important recommendation made by the Radhakrishnan Committee is that outsourcing in examinations should be completely abolished. At a time when the confidentiality of examinations is being breached repeatedly, it is not right for an agency like NTA to conduct examinations on contract and take help from outsiders in conducting them. There is a strong possibility that these outsiders are responsible for the irregularities in the examinations. The recommendation of the Radhakrishnan Committee that private schools should be avoided as far as possible from being made examination centres will be helpful in maintaining the credibility of the examinations. Since there are Kendriya Vidyalayas and Navodaya Vidyalayas in every part of the country, then they should be made examination centres. This is necessary because the copying mafia is able to make inroads in private schools in some way or the other. The suggestion of the Radhakrishnan Committee must be accepted that the NTA should conduct the examinations with the help of its own employees.
