## हैदराबाद हाउस में पीएम मोदी और कतर के अमीर की बैठक, कई अहम मुद्दों पर बनी सहमति

कतर के अमीर का राष्ट्रपति भवन में राष्ट्रपति द्रौपदी मुर्मू और पीएम मोदी ने स्वागत किया। इसके बाद अमीर तमीम बिन हमद अल थानी को सरकार के वरिष्ठ मंत्रियों से मिलवाया गया। नई दिल्ली स्थित हैदराबाद हाउस में प्रधानमंत्री नरेंद्र मोदी और कतर के अमीर तमीम बिन हमद अल थानी के बीच बैठक हुई। इस उच्च स्तरीय बैठक में दोनों देशों का प्रतिनिधिमंडल भी शामिल हुआ। इससे पहले कतर के अमीर तमीम बिन हमद अल थानी का मंगलवार को राष्ट्रपति भवन में भव्य स्वागत किया गया। इस दौरान कतर



के अमीर को राष्ट्रपति भवन में गाई ऑफ ऑनर दिया गया। अमीर अल थानी का राष्ट्रपति भवन में राष्ट्रपति द्रौपदी मुर्मू और पीएम मोदी ने स्वागत किया। इसके बाद अमीर तमीम बिन हमद अल थानी को सरकार के वरिष्ठ मंत्रियों से मिलवाया गया। कतर के अमीर राष्ट्रपति द्रौपदी मुर्मू के

साथ भी बैठक करेंगे। राष्ट्रपति भवन में कतर के अमीर के सम्मान में भोज का भी आयोजन किया जाएगा। अमीर अल-थानी कल यानी 17 फरवरी की रात को भारत पहुंचे थे। प्रधानमंत्री नरेंद्र मोदी प्रोटोकॉल तोड़कर खुद कतर के अमीर का स्वागत करने इंदिरा गांधी इंटरनेशनल एयरपोर्ट

पहुंचे थे। इस दौरान विदेश मंत्री एस जयशंकर भी मौजूद थे। कतर के अमीर 17 फरवरी को दो दिवसीय यात्रा पर भारत पहुंचे हैं। उनकी इस यात्रा का उद्देश्य भारत और कतर के द्विपक्षीय संबंधों को मजबूत करना है। साल 2024 के अंत में विदेश मंत्री एस जयशंकर ने भी कतर का दौरा किया था।

यहां उन्होंने कतर के प्रधानमंत्री और विदेश मंत्री मोहम्मद बिन अब्दुल रहमान अल थानी से मुलाकात की थी। यह एक साल में उनकी चौथी कतर यात्रा थी। सोमवार को दोनों देशों के बीच दो समझौता ज्ञापन पर हस्ताक्षर भी हुए। इस दौरान भारत के वाणिज्य मंत्री पीयूष गोयल और कतर के वाणिज्य और उद्योग मंत्री शेख फैसल बिन थानी भी मौजूद रहे। ये समझौता ज्ञापन दोनों देशों के बीच साझा व्यापार से जुड़े हैं। पीयूष गोयल ने इस दौरान कहा कि दोनों देशों के बीच व्यापार और निवेश की बड़ी संभावनाएं हैं। कतर के अमीर के साथ प्रतिनिधिमंडल में कई मंत्री और वरिष्ठ अधिकारी भी भारत दौर पर आए हैं। इससे पहले मार्च 2015 में कतर के अमीर ने भारत का दौरा किया था। कतर में बड़ी संख्या में भारतीय मूल के लोग रहते हैं और कतर के विकास में भारतवंशी समुदाय की अहम भूमिका है।

## नए सीईसी की नियुक्ति के 'आधी रात के फैसले' पर राहुल का बड़ा हमला; बोले- यह अपमानजनक और अशिष्ट

राहुल गांधी ने एक्स पर एक पत्र साझा करते हुए पोस्ट में लिखा कि जब मुख्य चुनाव आयुक्त की नियुक्ति प्रक्रिया को सुप्रीम कोर्ट में चुनौती दी जा रही है, तब आधी रात को नए मुख्य चुनाव आयुक्त के चयन का फैसला लेना प्रधानमंत्री, गृहमंत्री के लिए अपमानजनक और अशिष्ट है। चुनाव आयुक्त ज्ञानेश कुमार को पदोन्नत करके नया मुख्य निर्वाचन आयुक्त (सीईसी) बनाया गया है देश के नए मुख्य चुनाव आयुक्त की नियुक्ति पर कांग्रेस नेता राहुल गांधी ने केंद्र सरकार पर हमला बोला है। उन्होंने कहा कि जब मुख्य चुनाव आयुक्त की नियुक्ति प्रक्रिया को सुप्रीम कोर्ट में चुनौती दी जा रही है, तब आधी रात को नए मुख्य चुनाव आयुक्त के चयन का फैसला लेना प्रधानमंत्री, गृहमंत्री के लिए अपमानजनक और अशिष्ट है। राहुल गांधी ने एक्स पर एक पत्र साझा करते हुए पोस्ट में लिखा कि अगले मुख्य चुनाव आयुक्त का चयन करने के लिए हुई समिति की बैठक के दौरान मैंने प्रधानमंत्री और गृहमंत्री को एक असहमति नोट प्रस्तुत किया था। इसमें कहा गया था कि कार्यपालिका के हस्तक्षेप से मुक्त स्वतंत्र चुनाव आयोग का सबसे बुनियादी पहलू चुनाव आयुक्त और मुख्य चुनाव आयुक्त को चुनने की प्रक्रिया है। उन्होंने कहा कि सुप्रीम कोर्ट के आदेश का उल्लंघन करके और भारत के मुख्य न्यायाधीश को समिति से हटाकर मोदी सरकार ने चुनावी प्रक्रिया की ईमानदारी को लेकर करोड़ों मतदाताओं की चिंताओं को बढ़ा दिया है। विपक्ष के नेता के रूप में यह



मेरा कर्तव्य है कि मैं बाबासाहब आंबेडकर और हमारे राष्ट्र निर्माताओं के आदर्शों को कायम रखूँ और सरकार को जवाबदेह ठहराऊँ। उन्होंने कहा कि प्रधानमंत्री और गृहमंत्री द्वारा नए मुख्य चुनाव आयुक्त के चयन का आधी रात को निर्णय लेना अपमानजनक और अशिष्टपूर्ण है। जबकि समिति की संरचना और प्रक्रिया को सर्वोच्च न्यायालय में चुनौती दी जा रही है। इस पर 48 घंटे से भी कम समय में सुनवाई होनी है। राहुल गांधी ने अपने असहमति नोट में लिखा कि जून 1949 में एक स्वतंत्र चुनाव आयोग की स्थापना पर चर्चा के लिए संविधान सभा में बोलते हुए डॉ. बाबा साहब आंबेडकर ने भारत के लोकतंत्र और चुनाव आयोग के मामलों में कार्यपालिका के हस्तक्षेप के बारे में चेतावनी दी थी। कार्यपालिका के हस्तक्षेप से मुक्त स्वतंत्र चुनाव आयोग का सबसे बुनियादी पहलू चुनाव आयुक्त और मुख्य चुनाव आयुक्त को चुनने की प्रक्रिया है। दो मार्च 2023 को एक फैसले में सर्वोच्च न्यायालय की सांविधानिक पीठ ने आदेश दिया कि मुख्य चुनाव आयुक्त और चुनाव आयुक्तों की नियुक्ति प्रधानमंत्री, नेता प्रतिपक्ष और मुख्य न्यायाधीश की एक समिति द्वारा की जानी चाहिए। सुप्रीम कोर्ट के फैसले ने हमारी

चुनावी प्रक्रिया की अखंडता को लेकर लाखों मतदाताओं के बीच व्यापक चिंता को उजाड़ा। यह सार्वजनिक सर्वेक्षणों में भी दिखता है। यह भारत की चुनाव प्रक्रिया और संस्थानों में मतदाताओं के विश्वास में लगातार गिरावट दिखा रहा है। दुर्भाग्य से सुप्रीम कोर्ट के आदेश के तुरंत बाद भारत सरकार ने अगस्त 2023 में एक कानून लागू किया। इसने सुप्रीम कोर्ट के आदेश की भावना को दरकिनार कर दिया। कानून ने प्रधानमंत्री, विपक्ष के नेता और प्रधान मंत्री द्वारा नियुक्त एक केंद्रीय कैबिनेट मंत्री को शामिल करने और मुख्य न्यायाधीश को समिति से हटाने के लिए सीईसी और चुनाव आयुक्तों की नियुक्ति के लिए समिति का पुनर्गठन किया। यह सुप्रीम कोर्ट के आदेश की मूल भावना का घोर उल्लंघन है। इस आदेश को बाद में एक जनहित याचिकाकर्ता द्वारा चुनौती दी गई थी। सुप्रीम कोर्ट ने 48 घंटे से भी कम समय बाद 19 फरवरी 2025 को मामले पर सुनवाई करने के अपने इरादे का संकेत दिया है। कांग्रेस पार्टी का मानना है कि अगले सीईसी को चुनने की प्रक्रिया को सुप्रीम कोर्ट की सुनवाई तक टाल दिया जाए और इस बैठक को टाल दिया जाए। इस समिति के लिए अगले सीईसी को चुनने की अपनी प्रक्रिया को जारी रखना संस्थानों के साथ-साथ हमारे देश के संस्थापक नेताओं के लिए भी अपमानजनक और असह्य होगा, जब इस समिति की संरचना और प्रक्रिया को चुनौती दी जा रही है और जल्द ही सुप्रीम कोर्ट द्वारा सुनवाई की जाएगी।

**नए मुख्य चुनाव आयुक्त होंगे ज्ञानेश कुमार, उत्तर प्रदेश से खास नाता; राजीव कुमार की जगह लेंगे**  
देश के नए मुख्य चुनाव आयुक्त (सीईसी) के नाम की घोषणा कर दी गई है। चुनाव आयुक्त ज्ञानेश कुमार को पदोन्नत करके नया मुख्य निर्वाचन आयुक्त (सीईसी) बनाया गया है। ज्ञानेश कुमार के अलावा एक निर्वाचन आयुक्त की नियुक्ति भी की गई है। इसके लिए पीएम मोदी की अध्यक्षता में बैठक हुई, जिसमें केंद्रीय गृह मंत्री अमित शाह और लोकसभा में नेता प्रतिपक्ष विपक्ष के नेता राहुल गांधी शामिल हुए। चुनाव आयुक्त ज्ञानेश कुमार को भारत का मुख्य चुनाव आयुक्त (सीईसी) नियुक्त किया गया। मौजूदा मुख्य चुनाव आयुक्त राजीव कुमार का कार्यकाल आज (18 फरवरी) को खत्म हो रहा है। उनकी रिटायरमेंट के बाद ज्ञानेश कुमार सीईसी का पदभार संभालेंगे। खास बात ये है कि वे चुनाव आयुक्तों की नियुक्ति से संबंधित नए कानून के तहत नियुक्त होने वाले पहले मुख्य निर्वाचन आयुक्त होंगे। 1988 बैच के केरल कैड के आईएएस अधिकारी ज्ञानेश कुमार मार्च, 2024 से ही चुनाव आयुक्त के रूप में काम कर रहे थे। उन्हें पदोन्नत किया गया है। उनका कार्यकाल 26 जनवरी, 2029 तक होगा। ज्ञानेश कुमार पर इस साल बिहार का विधानसभा चुनाव और अगले साल पश्चिम बंगाल, असम और तमिलनाडु का चुनाव संपन्न कराने की जिम्मेदारी होगी। नियुक्ति के लिए पीएम नरेंद्र मोदी की अध्यक्षता में बैठक हुई। बैठक में केंद्रीय गृह मंत्री अमित शाह और कांग्रेस नेता व लोकसभा में नेता विपक्ष राहुल गांधी शामिल हुए।

## सीएम योगी बोले- भोजपुरी, अवधी का विरोध कर रहे सपा के लोग, बच्चों को मौलवी बनाना चाहते हैं

मुख्यमंत्री योगी आदित्यनाथ ने सपा पर हमला करते हुए कहा कि समाजवादियों का चरित्र दोहरा हो चुका है। ये लोग देश को कठमुल्लापन की ओर ले जाना चाहते हैं। उत्तर प्रदेश विधानसभा के बजट सत्र के पहले दिन मुख्यमंत्री योगी आदित्यनाथ ने विपक्ष, विशेष रूप से समाजवादी पार्टी, पर तीखा हमला बोला। उन्होंने कहा कि सपा अपने बच्चों को इंग्लिश मीडियम स्कूलों में पढ़ाएंगी और जब सरकार आम जनता के बच्चों को बेहतर सुविधाएं देने की बात करती है, तो ये लोग उर्दू थोपने की वकालत करने लगते हैं। उन्होंने आरोप लगाया कि सपा देश को कठमुल्लापन की ओर ले जाना चाहती है, जो कतई स्वीकार्य नहीं होगा। मुख्यमंत्री योगी आदित्यनाथ ने उत्तर प्रदेश की स्थानीय बोलियों भोजपुरी, अवधी, ब्रज और बुंदेलखंडी को विधानसभा की कार्यवाही में स्थान देने के फैसले का स्वागत किया। उन्होंने कहा कि इन बोलियों को हिंदी की उपभाषाएं मानते हुए सरकार इनके संरक्षण और संवर्धन के लिए प्रतिबद्ध है। सीएम योगी ने कहा कि हमारी सरकार इन भाषाओं के लिए अलग-अलग अकादमियों का गठन कर रही है, ताकि ये समृद्ध हों। ये हिंदी की बेटियां हैं और इन्हें उचित सम्मान मिलना चाहिए। यह सदन केवल विद्वानों के लिए नहीं है, बल्कि समाज के हर वर्ग की आवाज को यहां स्थान मिलना चाहिए। उन्होंने कहा कि जो लोग

# This partnership of big and small

Of course, American President Donald Trump gave a warm welcome to Prime Minister Modi in the White House. He was called a 'great leader' and Trump wrote on his book - 'You are great'. Trump also missed Modi a lot. This may be a formal gesture, although Trump has not used such words in relation to any other global leader, but along with their 'eleven-day friendship', both of them are also the supreme leaders of their respective countries, so both are committed to make their countries 'great again'. Both India and America are huge and ancient democracies, but it is also a reality that in this summit dialogue, America has the power of a senior country and India has been that of a junior partner country. This tradition and this imbalance of power has been there between America and India, because it is a country with an economy 8 times bigger than ours. Both countries have been fighting a joint battle against terrorism since the 9/11 terrorist attack in New York. America has decided to hand over Tahawwur Rana, a diabolical conspirator of the 26/11 Mumbai terror attack, to India. We should be grateful for that, perhaps some closed and mysterious links of terrorism can be opened. But Tahawwur has been in American jail since 2009. America is handing him over to us after a long 16 years, so this is a questionable situation. Global leaders have been expressing their concern on terrorism and have also been making public statements of a joint fight, but the reality is that every country has its own fight against terrorism. It will be a relief that our court will be able to take a decision on Tahawwur's terrorism and even send him to death. Anyway, President Trump has made his policy clear on the issue of tariff or customs duty. It is in the context of all countries. Both the heads of governments have not clarified anything on tariff between India and America. It has definitely been announced that a trade agreement can be reached at the end of the year. President Trump is basically a person of mercantilist mindset, hence he wants to expand US military deals with India so that the trade deficit can be reduced. The US President has offered to give India the state-of-the-art F-35 stealth fighter aircraft with this intention. The US has certainly sold this aircraft to NATO countries. India will be the first country outside them. Of course, this is the only 5th generation fighter aircraft. At present, the matter is limited to the offer, the proposal only, because India will also have to keep its military needs in mind. India has sufficient strength of Rafale fighter aircraft, which is a 4-5 generation aircraft. Of course, the armored vehicle that the US has talked about giving to India, can prove to be useful in areas like Ladakh, Rajasthan and Arunachal Pradesh. President Trump and Prime Minister Modi also discussed about illegal Indian immigrants. Prime Minister Modi accepted that illegal immigrants have no legal right to live in any other country, hence he gave his approval to take back such Indians, but Modi urged Trump that this is a long battle. Joint action will have to be taken against human trafficking fraudsters.

## Obstacles to the goal of developed India, we have to do wonders in the field of technology and AI

The basis of the progress of digital technology lies in the knowledge of science. The countries which will be the leaders in digital science and technology will rule the world. In the recent Artificial Intelligence Summit held in Paris, it was clear from the statement of US Vice President JD Vance that America is gearing up to remain the leader in all the fields of AI. Prime Minister Modi's goal of developed India is commendable. All the countrymen should focus on this goal of his. Prime Minister Modi has been repeatedly saying that India should achieve the goal of developed country by 2047. In 2047, we will complete 100 years of our independence. This is a difficult goal, because 2047 is now only 22 years away. 22 years pass in the blink of an eye in the lifetime of a country. Even after this, if we Indians commit ourselves to achieving the goal of developed India, then all the obstacles can be easily overcome. To achieve the goal of developed India, educated India, healthy India and prosperous India are also required. Along with this, there is also a need for a socially peaceful India and that the political class of the country should forget its ideological differences and agree on measures to maintain an atmosphere of peace and harmony in the country and to face the security challenges. It is natural that we will have to give the highest importance to an educated India. The country will have to ensure that every citizen is educated. Special attention will have to be paid to the education of the youth. The good thing in this context is that at present people from almost all sections of the society want their children to get good education. This was not the case at the time of independence or the period after that. Special attention should be paid to improving the quality of primary and secondary education. The central and state governments should not completely depend on the private sector in improving the quality of education and should take the command in their own hands, so that the large number of students going to government schools can be ensured to get quality education. Additional attention should be paid to providing high level education in technology and science at all levels. We should not ignore the fact that ancient India was leading the world in many fields of science. Our ancient texts contain excellent knowledge on subjects ranging from medicine to astronomy. There is no doubt that ancient India was a leader in many fields of science, but it is also true that later our progress in this field stagnated. This stagnation continued for centuries. From the 15th century, European countries started making progress in the field of science and technology. With progress in these fields, their military power also increased. After this, the Industrial Revolution came in these countries in the 19th century. This made Europe so powerful that large parts of Asia, Africa and South America became its colonies. India too became a colony of Britain and also became a victim of its exploitation. Our leaders of the freedom movement realized that one of the main reasons for India's decline was lagging behind in the field of science and technology. After independence, Jawaharlal Nehru became the Prime Minister. He can be blamed for many policy mistakes, but the country should be grateful to him for the fact that he showed full commitment to bridge the gap in the field of science and technology between Europe and India. He took special interest in establishing advanced institutions of science and technology. Some of these achieved international fame and some proved helpful in the Green Revolution and industrial progress. It can be debated that Nehruji should have trusted the private sector more, but it cannot be denied that due to the institutions established by him, the gap between the West and India in many areas of science and technology including nuclear and space decreased.
