The state, awaiting the droplets of debate in the Zero Room of the RDG, or revenue deficit grant from the center, is facing its own economic drought. We could even say that so and so is to blame for this situation. This was also a competition to see how to use the central relief. Politics, especially the BJP, has accepted that the Sukhu government is on a weak wicket, but this joy is laced with tears. We cannot view the state through two mirrors during this economic crisis, but in the void of the RDG, the think tanks of the BJP and Congress are becoming arenas for separate debates. In this context, Friday's all-party meeting was a sad day. At the very least, the next steps on this issue should be identified. These drums cannot be played alone. We are all guilty of the economic crisis. In this predicament, we are reminded of the wasteful expenditure in the name of development, and at least those speeches by governments, when, in a celebratory manner, they declared, "We will not let there be a shortage of funds." Now, the situation is such that the central government has stripped a hill state of its economic garb. In such a situation, is the central government doing justice by making the government run naked, or is this punishment waking us from our slumber? After all, such a massive structure didn't come up overnight. The past few decades have been marked by the exploits of various chief ministers. In Himachal, we have been squandering financial resources, burning budgets for political victory. Governments, driven by the idea of ?? "Mission Repeat," bargained with the public, beyond the state's capacity, reality, and potential, and found neither Maya nor Ram in them. We have made the economy the fiefdom of chief ministers and considered financial methods a slave to boasting. Clearly, opportunities in Himachal have been squandered in the pursuit of economic resources. When Himachal Pradesh emerged from the princely state and was igniting the fire of Punjab reorganization, no effort was made to advocate for economic rights. In this confusion, we insulted the land that was divided from Punjab to Himachal. No one considered that Kangra's Haldoon Valley wasn't limited to the Pong displacement, but its agricultural productivity needed to be resettled elsewhere. We kept looking for central funds, unable to discern between the real and the real. Without understanding the criteria and financial structure of central schemes, this state kept accumulating the cement of progress, but failed to build an economic foundation. It's right to cultivate dreams of employment in education policy, but by making employment a government slogan, we have turned the realm of thinking into politics. When lamps are lit in praise of leaders in every aspect of life, on every public platform, and at the annual celebrations of educational institutions, politics has become the primary ideal for generations. While our leaders continue to effect transfers, electricity transformers continue to burn. If this weren't the case, why would any doctor, employee, or official consider themselves wealthy in the guise of a politician? Furthermore, political patronage would prevent government positions, swindling, the peddling of government files, and the exploitation of ordinary citizens' compulsions. Governments would come and go, and employee cadres would change. Empty coats would remain on secretariat chairs. In a state where ministers are solely focused on making their constituencies shine, departmental competence would only last five years. Himachal Pradesh has always operated on a five-year grace period, so the debts of outgoing governments have created new mountains of debt. The sips of Shimla's tea and coffee failed to notice the state's soil being eroded. Now, we can see the nurseries of politicians becoming wealthy through.

Challenges Ahead of Trade Agreements: Producing High-Quality Goods at Attractive Prices a Priority

To become an economic superpower, India is emphasizing trade agreements, which will increase access to global markets. However, agreements alone will not suffice. The country needs to produce quality products at attractive prices, increase investment in research and development, facilitate trade, and collaborate with states. Advances in emerging technologies like AI and quantum computing, and energy production for them, are crucial to achieving true economic power. Trade agreements are the first step to becoming an economic superpower. Investment in quality products and research and development is essential. Self-reliance in AI and energy production is a significant challenge. There is no country in the world that has become an economic superpower solely on the strength of self-reliance without trade. According to economic historian Angus Maddison, India also became an economic superpower on the strength of trade. Its economy grew to over a quarter of the world's economy, earning it the nickname "Golden Bird." In the modern era, every country from Britain to the United States has become an economic superpower solely on the strength of trade, and now China is on the same path. After establishing its dominance in the US and European markets, it began opening new markets for its goods through trade agreements even before the walls of protectionism were erected. The Regional Comprehensive Economic Partnership Agreement (RCEP) signed four years ago was a continuation of this, involving 15 countries ranging from China and Japan to New Zealand. Free trade agreements pave the way for increased mutual trade and the emergence of an economic superpower. India has also opened a similar path by signing an agreement with Europe and finalizing its framework with the US. Before the US and Europe, it has already signed trade agreements with ASEAN, Japan, the UK, Australia, South Korea, Singapore, Oman, Mauritius, and four members of the European Free Trade Association. Negotiations are underway for a trade agreement with the Gulf Cooperation Council. Upon completion, these agreements will open up markets representing over 60 percent of the world's GDP. This transformation is nothing short of a transformation for a country that has bankrupted its economy by 40 years of protectionism. It's also true that trade agreements and access to major markets alone cannot make a country a commercial and economic superpower. To achieve this, high-quality goods must be produced and sold at attractive prices. The shackles of license raj and bureaucracy must be eased to establish industries. Research, development, and innovation must be enhanced in both the public and private sectors, as well as areas where the country is ahead of others. Capital must be made accessible and infrastructure must be improved. These measures have allowed China to increase its trade to one and a half times India's GDP, even during Trump's tariff war. Today, India's share of world trade is only 3.5 percent, while China's is approximately 14 percent. During its heyday, India's share of world trade was around 30 percent. Recently, during British Prime Minister Keir Starmer's visit to China, a British bicycle manufacturer was asked where it was easier to do business between China and the United States. He promptly replied, "China, where business is possible within a few weeks and there is also certainty regarding trade policy." India too will need to instill similar confidence in businesses to attract large-scale foreign capital. This will be impossible without the active and positive participation of the states, along with the central government. Industries, in addition to capital, require land, workers, electricity, and infrastructure, all of which fall under the jurisdiction of states that, instead of competing with each other to attract investment, are often busy creating obstacles. Otherwise, why is Tirupur in Tamil Nadu capable of becoming the new Manchester of the garment industry, while Kolkata and Kanpur fail to regain their lost luster in the textile industry? Bengal has a population equal to Vietnam's, but its GDP is half that of Vietnam. Bihar has a one-and-a-quarter the population of Vietnam and a quarter of its GDP. What can you do in the race for development if you can't even match a country devastated by a 20-year war? Through trade agreements, India has opened the doors to the world's rich markets, such as the US, Europe, Japan, and Russia. However, to increase demand for its goods, it requires continuous improvement in quality and attractive prices. This will not be possible without expanding production and investing in research and development. China and Vietnam spend over 2.5 percent of their budgets on research and development, while India spends only 0.65 percent. In the wave of protectionism sparked by Trump's tariff war, self-reliance in the defense sector has become paramount, which is impossible without significant investment in research and development. To become an economic superpower, simply increasing trade will no longer suffice. India must also remain ahead in emerging technologies like AI and quantum computing, and the energy technologies required for these technologies. In the past few months, major US tech companies have pledged investments totaling approximately \$80 billion to build AI data centers in India. These include names like Amazon, Microsoft, Google, and Intel. This is undoubtedly good news for the Indian economy, which has been struggling with declining foreign investment for the past few years. However, the massive energy requirements for these projects are beyond even Western developed nations. To build data centers and power-intensive AI models, India will need to increase its energy production to the scale of China, which currently produces two and a half times more electricity than the United States. Large-scale energy generation requires the development of clean energy sources like solar, wind, and hydrogen, ensuring the country's air remains breathable. The AI ??Impact Summit, which began in Delhi today, will address this issue, along with the need to make AI inclusive, people-friendly, and climate-friendly. This summit is expected to accelerate AI development, deployment, and investment in India.

MSMEs should become the foundation of a developed India and make them globally competitive.

This sector contributes approximately 35.4 percent of the country's total manufacturing output, approximately 48.58 percent of total exports, and approximately 31.1 percent of gross domestic product (GDP). Over 74.7 million enterprises in the country, employing approximately 328.2 million people, make this sector the second largest employer after agriculture. Globally, approximately 90 percent of businesses are in the MSME format and provide more than 50 percent of total global employment. As India's manufacturing sector moves towards global integration, the role of MSMEs is crucial in promoting effective supply chains, local value addition, and inclusive regional development. It is noteworthy that the Yashaswini Abhiyaan was launched on the occasion of "Entrepreneur India - MSME Day" in 2024, with the aim of promoting gender equality and ensuring a minimum three percent participation of women-owned MSMEs in public procurement by 2029. Last year, the Abhiyaan in Mizoram enabled the registration of approximately 8,400 women-owned MSMEs. To date, it has facilitated the registration of over 1.25 million women-owned MSMEs. The "Industrial Development Report 2024" published by the United Nations Industrial Development Organization (UNIDO) lists India among emerging industrial economies. According to the report, the manufacturing sector in countries like India is expanding rapidly and industrial diversification is increasing. It also states that India has the potential to strengthen its participation in global value chains. Although the MSME sector has made significant progress, some structural challenges remain. Issues such as delayed payments, lack of technological modernization, and limited global brand recognition continue to hamper the sector's momentum. While the number of registrations certainly paints a strong picture, there is a need to strengthen productivity per enterprise, quality standards, and global competitiveness. If these challenges are addressed through timely and effective policies, MSMEs can become a major pillar of a country's economic growth. The role of small and medium enterprises in the economic strength of South Korea and Japan is clearly visible. South Korea has provided small enterprises with research and development support, scale-up strategies, and legal protection through the Framework Act on Small and Medium Enterprises and the Ministry of Small, Medium Enterprises and Startups. On the other hand, Japan, under the Small and Medium Enterprise Basic Act, empowered its industries with a supply-chain-based "keiretsu" model, high quality standards, and technological innovation. The similarity between these two models is that they not only established a nurturing ecosystem for MSMEs, but also developed a structured system to elevate them to global competitiveness. If India similarly strengthens a clear scale-up policy and quality-oriented industrial coordination, MSMEs can further strengthen the foundation of a "developed India." In socio-economic development, MSMEs create substantial employment at low capital costs, support large industries as ancillary units, and promote industrialization in rural and backward areas. Therefore, India needs to provide long-term and affordable capital to MSMEs, encourage technological upgrading, and promote export-oriented brand building. Implementation of a timely payment mechanism and promotion of green production practices will also be essential. If MSMEs are given not just protection but a clear strategy to become globally competitive, they can become a crucial part of the economic structure of developed India. can be strengthened.

चांद नजर आया, मस्जिदों से किया गया ऐलान, शुरू हुआ मुकद्दस रमजान

गुरुवार को पहला रोजा रखा जाएगा। इसी के साथ एक माह तक चलने वाले रोजा, नमाज और इबादत के सिलसिले की शुरुआत होगी। बुधवार शाम को मगरिब की नमाज के बाद लोगों ने आसमान में चांद देखने की कोशिश की। चांद नजर आने की खबर मिलते ही मस्जिदों में तकबीरें गूंज उठीं। बच्चों और युवाओं में खासा उत्साह देखा गया। लोगों ने एक-दूसरे को रमजान की मुबारकबाद दी। रमजान इस्लामिक कैलेंडर का नौवां महीना है, जिसे रहमत, बरकत और मगफिरत का महीना माना जाता है। इस पूरे महीने में रोजेदार सुबह सहरी के समय भोजन कर रोजा शुरू करते हैं और सूर्यास्त के समय इफ्तार कर रोजा खोलते हैं। दिनभर भूखे-प्यासे रहकर अल्लाह की इबादत की जाती है और बुराइयों से दूर रहने का संकल्प लिया जाता है। उलेमा-ए-क़राम ने बताया कि रमजान आत्मशुद्धि, संयम और सामाजिक एकता का संदेश देता है। इस महीने में जकात और फितरा अदा कर ज़रूरतमंदों की मदद करने का विशेष महत्व है। रमजान को लेकर बाजारों में भी रौनक बढ़ गई है। खजूर, फल, सेवई, सूखे मेवे और अन्य खाद्य सामग्री की दुकानों पर भीड़ देखी जा रही है। सहरी और इफ्तार की तैयारियों में परिवार जुट गए हैं। उलेमाओं ने अपील की है कि रमजान के पाक महीने में इबादत के साथ-साथ आपसी भाईचारा, अमन-चैन और सद्भाव बनाए रखें। साथ ही स्वच्छता, संयम और सामाजिक जिम्मेदारियों का पालन करते हुए इस पवित्र माह का सम्मान करें। रमजान माह की शुरुआत को लेकर रोजेदार तैयारी में जुट गए हैं। मस्जिदों में जहां तैयारी की जा रही है वहीं बाजार में इसके लिए खरीदारी बढ़ गई है। शहर इमाम हकीम सैयद मासूम अली आजाद ने बताया कि बुधवार को चांद दिखने की उम्मीद है। यदि बुधवार की शाम चांद नजर आ जाता है तो जुमेरात को पहला रोजा रखा जाएगा। वहीं, अगर जुमेरात की रात चांद दिखाई देता है तो शुक्रवार को पहला रोजा रखा जाएगा। चांद के दीदार के बाद औपचारिक रूप से रमजान की शुरुआत का ऐलान किया जाएगा। उन्होंने बताया कि रमजान इस्लाम धर्म का सबसे पवित्र महीना माना जाता है, जिसमें रोजेदार सुबह सहरी के समय भोजन करने के बाद दिनभर रोजा रखते हैं और शाम को इफ्तार के साथ रोजा खोलते हैं। इस महीने में इबादत, तिलावत-ए-क़ुरान, तरावीह की नमाज और ज़रूरतमंदों को दान का विशेष महत्व होता है। मस्जिदों में साफ-सफाई और रोशनी की विशेष व्यवस्था की जा रही है, ताकि नमाजियों को किसी प्रकार की असुविधा न हो। इधर, बाजारों में भी रमजान की तैयारियों को लेकर भीड़ बढ़ गई है। लोग खजूर, सेवइयां, फलों और इफ्तार से जुड़ी अन्य खाद्य सामग्री की खरीदारी में जुटे हैं। इसके अलावा नए कपड़े, टोपी, इत्र और नमाज से संबंधित सामान की दुकानों पर भी ग्राहकों की आवाजाही बढ़ी हुई है। व्यापारियों का कहना है कि रमजान के चलते बिक्री में तेजी आई है और आने वाले दिनों में और अधिक रौनक की उम्मीद है।

उत्तर प्रदेश माध्यमिक शिक्षा परिषद की हाईस्कूल व इंटर परीक्षाएं कड़ी निगरानी के बीच शुरू हो गई। मुरादाबाद में 112 केंद्रों पर परीक्षा हुई। इस दौरान छात्र उत्साहित दिखे। मुरादाबाद में कड़ी निगरानी के बीच बोर्ड परीक्षाओं का आगाज हो गया। सुबह आठ बजे से ही परीक्षा केंद्रों पर विद्यार्थियों की भीड़ नजर आने लगी। प्रथम पाली में हाईस्कूल की परीक्षा सुबह साढ़े आठ बजे हिंदी प्रश्नपत्र के साथ शुरू हुई। केंद्रों पर सुरक्षा और व्यवस्थाओं को लेकर प्रशासन पूरी तरह सतर्क रहा। जिले में बनाए गए सभी केंद्रों पर मंगलवार से ही सीटिंग प्लान और अन्य व्यवस्थाएं दुरुस्त कर दी गई थीं। परीक्षा शुरू होते ही कंट्रोल रूम से ऑनलाइन निगरानी शुरू कर दी गई। हर गतिविधि पर नजर रखी जा रही है। मुरादाबाद में इस बार 112 परीक्षा केंद्र बनाए गए हैं। इसमें 19 केंद्र संवेदनशील घोषित किए गए हैं। हाईस्कूल में 39,560 और इंटरमीडिएट में 36,200 विद्यार्थी पंजीकृत हैं। 15 दिन तक चलने वाली इन परीक्षाओं में कुल 75,760 परीक्षार्थी शामिल होंगे। माध्यमिक शिक्षा विभाग की ओर से निगरानी के लिए पांच जोनल मजिस्ट्रेट, छह सचल दल, 18 सेक्टर मजिस्ट्रेट, दस रात्रिकालीन निगरानी दल, 112 स्टैटिक मजिस्ट्रेट, 112 केंद्र एवं बाह्य केंद्र व्यवस्थापक, एक संकलन केंद्र और तीन उप संकलन केंद्र बनाए गए हैं। जिला विद्यालय निरीक्षक देवेन्द्र कुमार पांडेय के अनुसार प्रश्नपत्रों से छेड़छाड़ की किसी भी संभावना को समाप्त करने के लिए दस रात्रिकालीन सचल दल गठित किए गए हैं। वह रात में भ्रमण कर केंद्रों के स्ट्रिंग रूम का निरीक्षण करेंगे। प्रशासन का दावा है कि परीक्षा निष्पक्ष और पारदर्शी ढंग से संपन्न कराई जाएगी।

चचेरे मामा ने की भांजे की हत्या, सिर में घुसा मिला धारदार हथियार; अवैध संबंधों में बन रहा था बाधा

रामपुर में अवैध संबंधों में बाधा बनने पर चचेरे मामा ने भांजे की दरांती से हमला कर हत्या कर दी। चीख सुनकर पहुंचे ग्रामीणों की सूचना पर पुलिस ने आरोपी को गिरफ्तार कर लिया है। पूरे घटनाक्रम की जांच की जा रही है। उत्तर प्रदेश के रामपुर जिले के स्वार में अवैध संबंधों में बाधक बने चचेरे मामा ने भांजे की हत्या कर दी। पुलिस ने आरोपी को गिरफ्तार कर लिया है। घटना से इलाके में सनसनी फैल गई है। पुलिस जांच में जुटी है। जानकारी के अनुसार, कोतवाली इलाके के मसवासी पुलिस चौकी के खौदकलां गांव में मंगलवार की रात लगभग पौने 12 बजे कथित अवैध संबंधों में बाधक बने चचेरे मामा ने भांजे मोहम्मद आकिल (28) की दरांती के प्रहार से हत्या कर दी। चीख निकलने पर पड़ोसी ने आरोपी को भागते हुए देखा। मौके पर तमाम ग्रामीण इकट्ठा हो गए। सूचना पर कोतवाल संजीव कुमार पुलिस बल के साथ पहुंचे और शव कब्जे में लेकर मोर्चरी भिजवा दिया। खौदकलां गांव के लोग मंगलवार की रात गहरी नींद में सो रहे थे तभी उन्होंने चीखों की आवाज सुनी। लोग घरों से बाहर निकल आए और वह मोहम्मद आकिल के घर पहुंचे तो वो रक्तर्जित अवस्था में मिला। उसके सिर में दरांती घुसी हुई थी। घटना के समय वह घर में अकेला था। सूचना मिलने पर कोतवाली और मसवासी चौकी पुलिस आ गई। पुलिस को आकिल मृत अवस्था में मिला। इसके चलते शव का पंचनामा भरने के बाद पोस्टमार्टम के लिए मोर्चरी भेज दिया। घर में अकेला रहता था आकिल - आकिल के माता-पिता का काफी साल पहले निधन हो चुका है। एक बहन थी वह भी शादी के बाद अपनी ससुराल में रह रही है। आकिल की शादी हो चुकी है लेकिन पत्नी शाइस्ता लगभग छह माह पहले उसे छोड़ तीन बच्चों को लेकर अपने मायके जाकर रहने लगी है। आरोप है कि आकिल को नशे की लत और आपराधिक गतिविधियों से नाराज होकर वह पहले भी कई बार पति को अकेला छोड़ कर मायके जा चुकी है। इस तरह अकील अपने घर में अकेला ही रह रहा था। चचेरे मामा पर हत्या का आरोप- गांव में उसके चचेरे मामा नसीम उर्फ भूरा रहता है। उसकी शादी हुई थी लेकिन पत्नी तलाक लेकर उसे छोड़ गई। बताते हैं कि भांजा मोहम्मद आकिल अपनी पत्नी को घर लाना चाहता था लेकिन वह आने को तैयार नहीं थी। बताते हैं कि वह ममेरे ससुर नसीम उर्फ भूरा के सांपर्क में थी। नसीम से मोबाइल पर बात करती थी। चर्चा है कि मोहम्मद आकिल को रास्ते से हटाकर वह उसकी पत्नी को खुद अपनी पत्नी बनाना चाहता था। संभव है कि इसी कारण मंगलवार की रात मोहम्मद आकिल की जघन्य हत्या कर दी गई। चचेरा मामा पुलिस की हिरासत में- चीख पुकार सुनकर पड़ोसियों ने देखा कि नसीम उर्फ भूरा, मोहम्मद आकिल के घर से भागने का प्रयास कर रहा था। भीड़ जमा होने के कारण वह भाग नहीं सका। इसी दौरान कुछ देर में पुलिस आ गई और उसे कब्जे में ले लिया गया। आकिल का है आपराधिक इतिहास- पुलिस और ग्रामीणों के मुताबिक आकिल का आपराधिक रिकॉर्ड भी रहा है। उसके खिलाफ थाना टांडा के अलावा उत्तराखंड के रुद्रपुर और हल्द्वानी में चोरी के कई मुकदमे दर्ज हुए। वह कई बार जेल भी जा चुका था। इसके अलावा वह नशा भी करने लगा। शाइस्ता पति की इन हरकतों से तंग रहती ही और उसे छोड़कर अपने तीन बच्चों के मायके में रहने लगी।

कैल्शियम बेचने की सूचना पर गुड़गांव से आई कंपनी टीम ने नगर के मुख्य चौराहे के निकट स्थित शर्मा फर्टिलाइजर की दुकान पर छापामार कार्रवाई कर एक नकली कैल्शियम का कट्टा बरामद किया। कार्रवाई के दौरान टीम ने दुकानदार को यारा वीरा नाइट्रोजन कैल्शियम का नकली कट्टा 500 रुपये में बेचते हुए रंगे हाथों पकड़ लिया। जबकि बाजार में इसी कंपनी के असली कैल्शियम कट्टे की कीमत लगभग 1400 रुपये बताई जा रही है। सस्ते दामों का लालच देकर किसानों के साथ खुलेआम धोखाधड़ी की जा रही थी। छापेमारी करने वाली टीम का नेतृत्व कर रहे एरिया मैनेजर धर्मेन्द्र कुमार ने तत्काल इसकी सूचना जिला कृषि अधिकारी कुलदीप सिंह को दी। सूचना मिलते ही जिला कृषि अधिकारी मौके पर पहुंचे और पूरे मामले की जानकारी ली। उन्होंने टीम को नकली खाद बेचने वालों के खिलाफ कड़ी कानूनी कार्रवाई के निर्देश दिए। टीम ने कैल्शियम के नमूने लेकर लैब को भेजा है। कार्रवाई के दौरान नगर व आसपास के ग्रामीण क्षेत्रों के खाद बीज विक्रेताओं में हड़कंप मचा रहा। गौरतलब है कि क्षेत्र में लंबे समय से नकली खाद एवं कीटनाशक और कृषि दवाओं का अवैध कारोबार फल फूल रहा है। इसका सीधा नुकसान किसानों को उठाना पड़ रहा है, जहां मेहनत की कमाई लूटने के साथ साथ फसलें भी खराब हो रही हैं।

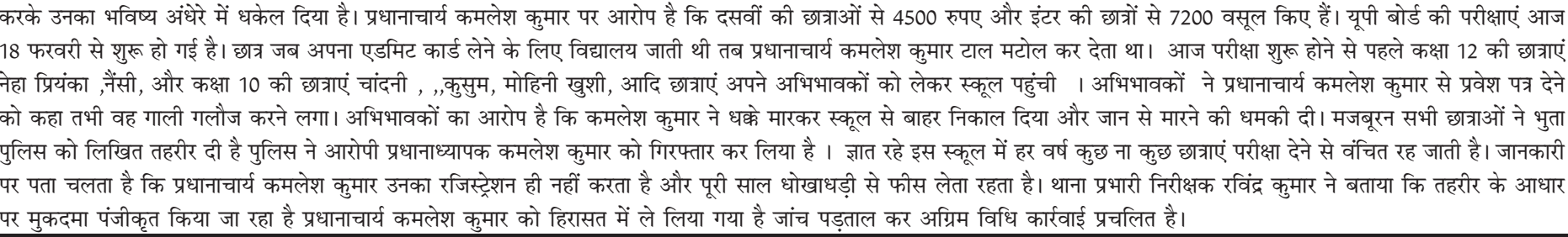
